### **Policy Statement**

#### **Summary**

West Yorkshire Police complies with Authorised Professional Practice (APP) which contains information to assist policing, and has established supplementary local procedures, where appropriate, to provide additional guidance to police officers and staff.

West Yokshire Police needs to maintain order at major sporting events and protect local communities from disorder, by the planning and policing of events, while having due regard to the principles of the Human Rights Act 1998.

The aims of this policy procedure are to explain how to plan and police major sporting events, in particular professional football matches; and the process for conducting community impact assessments.

#### Scope

This policy applies to all police officers and police staff.

### **Principles**

#### Summary

- The procedure applies to districts with a professional football club based in their territorial area. However, some of the procedure can be used for the policing of other major sporting events.
- Many of the minor sporting events are not 'policed' or are policed only at certain contentious fixtures.

#### **Equality Impact**

- When any police action is taken in relation to this procedure, individuals must take account of the impact on diverse groups.
- Where necessary, a community impact assessment must be conducted.
